## READ AND ROLL

This year's Read and Roll theme will be "Journey Around the World". Students will be challenged to read enough minutes from October 1, 2013 to February 28, 2014 to visit at least 15 different Wonders of the World. The program will work as follows:

- Each student will receive an "Are you a World Class Reader" worksheet\*. This worksheet will be due back to the teacher the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month.
- Each student should read a minimum of 20 minutes a day. The number of minutes read each day and the total read for the month should be recorded on the worksheet.
- The school's progress will be tracked on a World Map in the hallway. One minute read will be equal to 30 miles traveled.
- Each class' progress will also be tracked. The class in each grade level that reads the most minutes will win an ice cream party at the end of the year.
- If Cherry Hill School achieves the goal, Mrs. Heitman will participate in a very exciting activity with the children. The exact activity will be announced at a later date.
- For every month a student hands in a worksheet, his/her name will be entered into the monthly raffle (prizes TBD). There will be one prize awarded monthly for each grade 1-6.
- For every month a student hands in a worksheet, his/her name will be entered into the grand prize raffle. The grand prize will be a NOOK HD Tablet. There will be one prize awarded for each grade 1-6 at the end of the program.
- At the end of the program, the top readers in each grade level will be entered into the "Most Minutes" read raffle. There will be one prize awarded for each grade 1-6 at the end of the program.
